December Regional Learning Session Recap

HCGC recently hosted our third and final Regional Learning Session of 2018, bringing together nearly 100 local stakeholders to discuss how transportation affects Ohio's health priorities, particularly for vulnerable populations, and community best practices and solutions to address local challenges.

Participants heard from Amy Bush Stevens with the Health Policy Institute of Ohio about how Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) affects all areas of the State Health Improvement Plan and discussed specific areas where transportation (or lack thereof) is most impactful on health outcomes. The Ohio Department of Medicaid provided an update on work they are doing to address transportation for vulnerable populations across Ohio. To wrap up the session, Loren Anthes from The Center for Community Solutions moderated a panel of local leaders as they discussed best
